

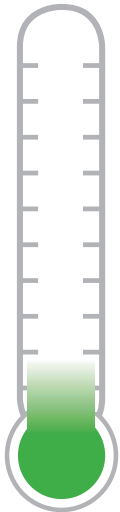
## Verse of the Month:

## Meet Our Board of Directors Fred Hosillos



Fred was born and raised in the Philippines, in the town of Iloilo. He discovered the benefits of regular exercise and healthy living and started a marathon training clinic in Iloilo. Motivating people to become healthy both spiritually and physically became a mission for Fred. In 1983 Fred moved his family to Los Angeles on an invitation from an Adventist minister to start a marathon training clinic. He began the Adventist Marathon Clinic and realized his dream of becoming a full-time health educator and pastor for his church. During his years in Los Angeles, Fred became a licensed skilled nursing home administrator and knew in his heart this was another mission he had been given.

In 2006, Fred felt his missions in Los Angeles were complete and felt it was time to move on. His sister was living in Redmond at this time and suggested he and his wife come and check out Prineville. Fred recalled, "As we were driving down the grade from Redmond, our jaws just dropped open when we saw the beautiful courthouse, Meadow Lakes Golf Course, and the whole set up of the town." They knew this was the community they were seeking.

When Pastor Matt Huff began organizing the Redemption House board, he invited Fred to be a member to sit on the original board. He and Pastor Matt knew each other through involvement in Church events in town, and also through Fred's work as a Supported Employment Specialist at Lutheran Community Services. Serving the poor and marginalized in society has been instilled in Fred since his youth as he watched his parents reach out to take in nephews and nieces of much poorer relatives and yet care for their 9 children. Fred just began his third year on the Redemption House board. His goal for Redemption House is financial stability. "To my community," Fred states, "let us all rally together to support Redemption House financially, and in any other way we can. This ministry is a gift to us, to provide a decent shelter for our homeless brothers and sisters. Yes, I do believe that we are our brothers' and sisters' keepers, to a certain degree!"
